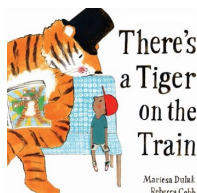
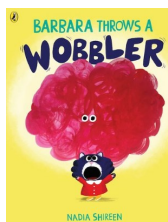


Father Christmas visit



At the end of term, Father Christmas and the Christmas Elf visited each class and gave us the wonderful present of a class book to read and share!

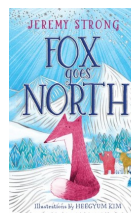
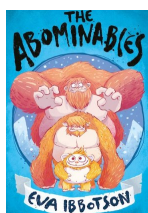

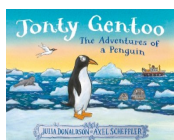

Thank you so much for your continued support for our Reading Shed since it opened in May 2024!

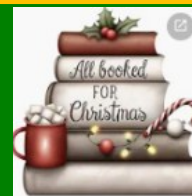

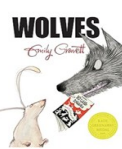

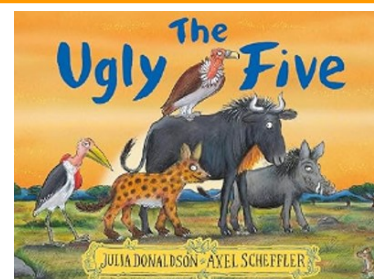


Christmas Fayre
